I am enclosing for your information a photostatic copy of a report of the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture, dealing with the effect of Capacitron radiation on various insects. In reference to our recent discussions we thought that you would be interested in this report. The dosages mentioned are maximal rather than minimal since we were predominantly interested in 100% killing and the survivals in the potatoes were probably due to the fact that the insects were beyond the penetration range. Since we only have two photostats of this report, I would appreciate your returning it to us after your perusal.
