Estimados Compañeros y Compañeras:

The National Chicano Moratorium Committee is in the process of organizing the 25th Commemoration March and Rally of the Chicano Moratorium of August 29, 1970. This historic evento will take place on August 26, 1995. We will begin with a rally at 9am in Belvedere Park in East Los Angeles and will follow the original 1970 route to Salazaar Park where a rally will also be held with speakers and cultura.

The NCMC is not organizing this acto for merely historical reasons. When we marched in 1970, it was to protest the US Imperialist War against the people of Vietnam(in which 20% of the US military casualties were Chicano Mexicanos though we made up only 6% of the US population) and the oppression we face in our barrios throughout Aztlan/Occupied Mexico. Today, we can see that conditions facing Raza are actually worse than they were 25 years ago in spite of the heroic struggles of our Movimiento. It is to combat these conditions and to bring about a greater unity among our gente and among those independent organizations that struggle for Raza liberation and self-determination that we have called for a massive mobilization on August 26.

It is only organized struggle that we can defend our gente from US government and Media sponsored Mexican-bashing that is at a fever pitch. It is only through organized struggle that we can end police/migra violence against our gente in our barrios. It is only through organized, independent struggle that we can end the madness of barrio violence which is instigated by the police. It is only through organized struggle that we can secure adequate housing, healthcare, culturally relevant education, decent jobs and wages, and control of the social, political, educational institutions that affect us in our barrios. It is only through organized struggle that we can support the heroic struggle of the Ejercito Zapatista de Liberacion Nacional and other independent organizations struggling for Mexicano self-determination and liberation south of a gringo imposed border as we struggle here. We are one Raza and the oppression we face is the same from Denver to el Distrito Federal, from San Jose to San Cristobal, From Taos to Tamaulipas.

The NCMC also understands that we are not immigrants. No amount of Mexican-bashing by the Clinton Administration or racist politicians like Pete Wilson will change the fact that we are the indigenous people to this tierra and that the only "illegal alien" is the gringo invader. We didn't cross the Border, the Border crossed us!!

For these reasons, the NCMC is calling on all Raza to mobilize and come to this historic Marcha on August 26, 1995. Please, get out the materials we have sent to your organization if you belong to one or to other raza you know if you don't. Form committees to go to the marcha and work to form a region of the National Chicano Moratorium Committee in your region. Organize buildup events, press conferences, fundraisers, etc. to mobilize our gente and get the word out to everywhere there are Chicano Mexicanos. Our movimiento needs strong, principled unity to build the struggle of resistance of our gente. Now is the time to unite on a national level with a national platform of self-determination and a national plan of Raza Resistance. Unidos Venceremos.


