I levelled and put into alfalfa the 160 neres adjoining the railroad and have sold on 10 year contracts 240 agree to good Portugese, at an average of nearly \$500 an acre, but I had to put \$4,000 worth of improvements on each 80 acres.

In a couple of years I will work this thing all out in fine shape. Our well is holding up splendidly.
