We are just in receipt of your letter of June 10th and note that a mutual friend, Mr. Arthur Taylor, has referred you to us for figures on certain track and material. We are enclosing our quotation.

The weights which we have given you are approximated and are as near correct as we can figure. We are quoting you prices f.o.b. Los Angeles. Our San Diego and Oceanside prices are approximated, and might vary a shade one way or the other. We base these rates on the present rates of freight, as given us this morning. While we cannot guarantee the San Diego and Oceanside prices, we think you will find them O.K. You can appreciate how difficult it is to arrive at any accurate basis.

You specify 20# rails. For your information, these rails are not stocked locally, the heaviest rail being 16# which is 2 3/8" base as opposed to 2 5/8" base on the 20#, is 2 3/8" high as opposed to 2 5/8" high on the 20#. So you can see it is 1/4" smaller. We are therefore taking the liberty of quoting you on the 16# rail, and trust this will fill your bill.

Regarding motors, we regret that we are not in a position to give you the desired information. Think possibly the Western Electric Company of this city might be able to handle this part of your inquiry satisfactorily.

Regarding shipment we can practically make immediate shipment, that is, within a day on the entire order, and would be glad to hear from you.
