Dear Sir:

By letter of May 26, the Acting Secretary of Agriculture informed the Secretary of the Interior that you had executed the stipulation required for the protection of the Cleveland National Forest and that so far as the Forest Service was concerned, there was no objection to the approval of your application for a canal for irrigation purposes.

It is understood that you do not at present intend to develop power but that it may be possible to generate power at some time in the future. Since your grant under the irrigation right-of-way law will not authorize the use of the canal for power purposes it will be necessary for you to obtain a permit under the water-power regulations when you begin to develop power.

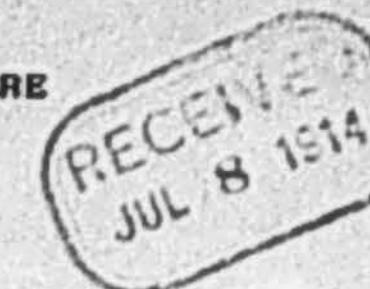

Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of a communication from Messrs. Murray and Fletcher dated October 6, 1914, enclosing a map of "Addition to Boulder Creek Reservoir of Murray and Fletcher". I am also in receipt of a communication from Mr. W. S. Post, Engineer for Murray and Fletcher, dated October 7, 1914, enclosing signed stipulations for the Boulder Creek Project.

As already explained to you verbally, the signed stipulations are correct in every thing save that the payment is made by check, which is, of course, contrary to the Regulations. It is my understanding that you will rectify this error by making a cash payment on Tuesday next, Monday being a bank holiday.

Upon examination of the map of the addition to Boulder Creek Reservoir, the following has been noted:-

The point of diversion is moved downstream almost one-half a mile, and although no conduit levels are shown, it

appears that the outlet from the new dam into the conduit will be some 70 feet lower vertically than the outlet of the original reservoir. This alteration in the conduit line will throw it entirely out of the belt of topography shown on the original filing maps; also the new map shows no contours within the reservoir site, nor any of the other data called for by the Regulations.


The changes made are so radical that it will be necessary for Messrs. Murray and Fletcher to file a new set of maps, duplicating for the new reservoir and conduit locations Exhibits E-5, E-2-a Sheets 3, 4, 5 and 6, E-1-a, E-2-a Sheet 1, E-2-a Sheet 2, E-1-c, E-1-b of the original locations. It was presupposed in making out the above list that the types of conduit of Exhibit E-2-b and power plant arrangement Exhibit E-3 of the original application are to remain the same. It will not be necessary to show, in accordance with the power regulations, the data which was originally filed for the Tule Conduit extending from the center of Section 7 to the center of the Northwest quarter of Section 20, T. 14 S. R. 3 E., nor will it be necessary to show the data for the Tule Reservoir which was also filed. Only such maps as are required by the Special Use Regulations need be filed for these last two portions of the original project. Mr. Post can get the necessary information for drawing up these maps from the Forest Supervisor with whom they should be filed. It is my

understanding that later on he will file application for an easement under the Regulations of the Interior Department, covering the system from the forebay southward.

The signed stipulations for the original project will be forwarded immediately to Washington, with a recommendation that a permit be issued. Mr. Post may, in the mean time, prepare the necessary maps for the amended location, and upon their receipt the proper action will be taken by this office. It is probably, however, that since the project is a small one the time for beginning and completion of construction will not be extended.
