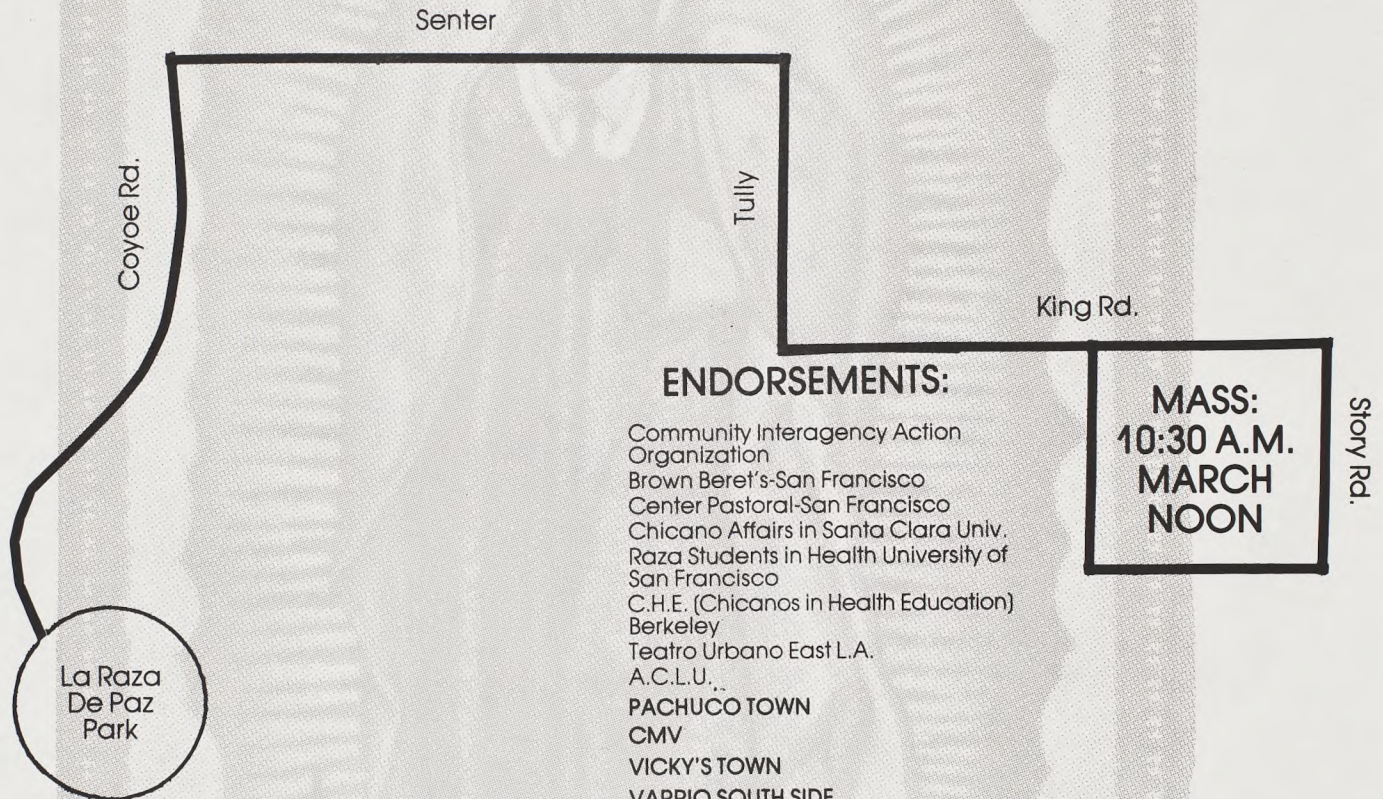

CHICANO SPIRITUAL WALK

Carnales y Carnalaz,

Here we are talking about the first Chicano Spiritual Walk protesting the injustices done to our people. We must bring unity and spiritual strength to all our Gente. We must remember that we are walking for the Love of our people not the Hate of our enemy and only with the peoples spiritual strength we will have justice. THE Chicano Spiritual Walk Takes place March 24, 1979

Here are some of the injustices done to our Gente:

1. Education: Racial Attitudes with the school system using discriminatory survey to justify Bilingual-Bicultural program, when it should be a right, not a privilege.
2. Welfare Discrimination- Dealing with the attitudes and policy of the department itself, to mostly monitor and not service.
3. Police Abuse- Racial Misconduct and the use of excessive force.
4. House Discrimination- The high cost of rental for defective condition of housing.
5. Employment- Discrimination Racial discrimination and sexual discrimination or cheap labor for war productions.
6. Drug Abuse- The involvement of the U.S. Government and the supplying of the economic and technical aid and the political coverage over the drug use and not dealing with the producer of the product.
7. Land- The conflict with the P.G.E. against the native Americans at Pit River and Point conception and respect all treaty rights and also the treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo.
