Thank you very much for your letter of September 24th. I saw John Stonehocker this morning and he is equipped to clean up the blocks mentioned below in a satisfactory manner by mowing, raking and burning the rubbish, for \$25.00. He will include the hoeing of unsightly tall weeds that flank these blocks between the sidewalk and the curb. He will also rake up the accumulation of papers and rubbish on each side of the Highway within the city limits.

The blocks in question are Block 10, Lots 25 to 36 inclusive in Block 12, (these two blocks are on the east side of the track), and Block 15 and 17 on the west side of the track. I went over the territory with him this morning and we felt if these lots are cleared off, the town will make a much neater and more enterprising appearance. The other lots are not as conspicuous and are covered with their native brush which is not unsightly.

We would like to have your sanction to have John go on with this work.
