Answering yours of the 21st, will say that I will make a definite arrangement to furnish you water free, for a period of two years, the understanding being that this water is to be furnished for a public park at the El Monte Grove, now owned by the county.

I will make the arrangement for this length of time to see how things go, also the quantity of water used. If the public does not abuse the privilege, and it is only a small amount of water, I see no reason why the Cuyamaca Water Company should not make a donation of this water under all the circumstances, or at least subject to the approval of the State Railroad Commission of California, which has jurisdiction over our company.

If you desire to accept of this offer, please present this letter to the office of the Cuyamaca Water Company and arrangements will be made to furnish water as above stated.

In response to your letter of June 27th, I
transmit herewith two blueprints showing the results
of our study of the reservoir and damsites in Doane
Valley. These show the contours so that the flooded
area can be determined for any height of dam, and like-
wise the contours of the damsite itself, so that some
estimate can be made of the size of structure required
for any particular capacity. No detailed structural
designs of a dam were ever prepared.
