Dear Dean Coggeshall:

I have the honor to inform you that the officers of The Rockefeller Foundation have approved a grant of \$1,200, or as much thereof as may be necessary, to the University of Chicago for the seminar on the genetic aspects of viruses and bacterial problems which is to be held jointly by the University of Chicago and Indiana University during the coming academic year. It is understood that the fund is to be used toward the travel and living expenses of the participants, while away from home. The action taken makes the fund available during a one-year period beginning approximately September 1, 1949, and the grant will terminate one year from the date of the first payment.

Mr. H. M. Gillette, Assistant Comptroller of the Foundation will, upon request, take care of the payments under the grant. At the termination of the period of the grant, we would appreciate receiving a summary statement of the disbursements under it.
