Mr. Lynn Williams, Vice President of the University of Chicago, visited Puerto Rico during the past week and explained to a group from the Puerto Rico Development Company the electronic method of preserving food with the capacitron. Mr. Jaime Benitez, Chancellor of the University of Puerto Rico, has asked me to join this group as one of his consultants and as I understand that you have been connected with this project I would appreciate very much if you could send me any literature concerning this matter which may have available. I understand that on the March 1948 issue of Electronics and article was published by Dr. Huber but I have been unable to get hold of this paper. I do have the May 1948 issue of the Journal of Applied Physics which has two papers on the work done at the Massachussets Institute of Technology in this field. Our library is very poor as far as Scientific Journals are concerned, so I would appreciate any reprints you may be able to send me.

I met you when I was studying for the doctorate at Columbia University in 1939 but I am sure that you do not remember me. At present, besides teaching Physics, I am directing a Cosmic Ray project sponsored by the Atomic Energy Commission.
