- (d) Upon receipt of copy of the report of the Department of Public Welfare, Adoption Division, prepare Agreement (Section 227, C.C.) and Minor's Consent (Section 225, C.C. and Rule XV Superior Court) for signatures of the petitioners and of the minor, if necessary, before Court, and Decree of Adoption in duplicate (Section 227, C.C.). THE DECREE OF ADOPTION SHALL CONTAIN THE ADOPTED NAME OF THE MINOR BUT SHALL NOT CONTAIN THE NAME THAT THE MINOR HAD PRIOR TO ADOPTION (Section 226, C.C.). These unsigned pleadings should then be transmitted to the County Clerk's Office. An agency adoption involves the adoption of an unmarried minor where the minor was placed in the home of the petitioners by a licensed adoption agency, usually after the minor has been relinquished by its natural parents [see CC § 224m]. Where, in an unusual case, the agency is placing a minor who has not been relinquished to it, the adoption is similar to an



The petitioners received the minor from the legal father in November, 1974, and the minor has remained with them continuously since that time.

According to a recent medical report, the minor is in good health and appears to be developing normally. She appears to be adjusting satisfactorily in the petitioners' home. She is in the tenth grade at Mar Vista High School where her reports and grades are reported to be satisfactory.

NATURAL PARENTS:

According to the woman petitioner, the natural mother,
Silvina Lira, nee Suarez, was born in 1933 in Guadalajara, Mexico.
Her death certificate gives the date of her death as August 12,
1970 in Guadalajara, Mexico (verified).

The legal father, Carlos Haro Lira, adopted the minor in a step-parent adoption in Los Angeles Superior Court on November 24, 1969 (verified). The legal father has met the petitioners and is satisfied with them as parents for his child.

ADOPTING PARENTS:

The man petitioner, Juan Antonio Coronado Villanueva, was born May 8, 1941, in Guadalajara, Mexico. He received a tenth grade education. For the past four years he has been employed at the Classic III Supper Club where he is assistant manager. The physician who examined him on October 3, 1975 reported no evidence of organic

The man petitioner receives \$1,000.00 per month from his employment, (verified). The petitioners are purchasing a modest mobile home for \$7,000.00 on which they owe approximately \$4,000.00. They have no life insurance and modest other resources. The petitioners have supplied a financial statement to show that they are able to provide an adequate home for the minor.

The petitioners appear to have a compatible relationship and a basic understanding of the development and needs of children. This continuity is also very important to the extended family constellation. Emotional ties appear close, the petitioners wish to accept complete legal responsibility to insure the minor remaining with them. They accept the lack of complete background information on the minor. References state that they are proper persons to rear a minor child.

CONSENTS:

The legal father, claiming sole custody, freely and willingly

signed the attached consent on October 14, 1975 before a representative of the State Department of Health in Los Angeles County, California.

The minor freely and willingly signed the attached consent to her adoption on September 18, 1975 before a representative of the State Department of Health in San Diego County, California.

No consent from the natural mother is necessary as she is deceased.

EVALUATION:

It appears to the San Diego County Department of Public Welfare that the minor is available and adoptable and that the petitioners' home is a good setting for her.
