Will you please advise if this payment has been made to your office and if so will you kindly forward same to us.

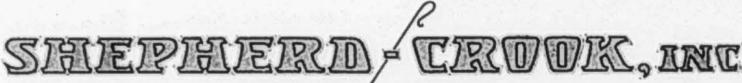
