This will acknowledge receipt of your check No. 19408 in the amount of \$27.29, given to Mr. McIntosh, which you have figured as follows:

James Blake payment	\$10.00
A. Escobido payment	15.00
Interest to June 17, 1929	2.29

We do not quite agree with you on the interest, and would request that you advise us how the same is figured.

For your information, we figure the interest to be as follows:

March 21 to April 21, \$250.00 for one month at 7%	1.46
April 21 to May 21, \$235.00 for one month at 7%	1.40
May 21 to June 21, \$220.00 for one month at 7%	1.29
Total	\$4.15

Less the amount included in your check of \$2.29, this would leave an apparent shortage of \$1.86.
