At a special meeting of the Board of Directors held September 26th, 1929, it was unanimously decided to levy an assessment against the various members of the San Elijo Gun Club of one hundred dollars per individual. Said assessment to take care of the various items of expense, such as taxes and shooting expenses.

The assessment was made against the stock- holders of the Club and not against the number of shares each member owned.
