My Dear Mr. Fletcher:

In reply to your letter of the 13th, beg to advise that at the present time our water rates through meters are as follows - I might state that this is the only way the District delivers water:

The irrigation rate is straight four cents per 100 cubic feet with no minimum charge. That is, the user is charged with exactly the amount of water that registers through his meter.

The combination rate, which is for small acreages of not more than three acres, is ten cents per 100 cubic feet for the first 1500, making a minimum of \$1.50. All over 1500 cubic feet is five cents per 100.

The domestic rate is:

First 500 cubic feet	20¢	per 100	Cu. Ft.
Next 1500 " " "	15¢	" " "	" "
Next 3000 " " "	10¢	" " "	" "
All over 5000 Cu Ft	07¢	" " "	" "

These rates were made by the Board to cover water delivered at cost to the District, but there is an additional cost which comes on our assessment covering bond interest and maintenance and operation charges. We have figured these out for irrigation only at the rate of four cents per 100 cubic feet and amounts to \$29.50 per acre for the average acre per year, based on the rate of one acre foot per acre.

I am enclosing with this letter an annual report of the District and refer you to Page 21, which will give you in detail information relative to assessments. I am also enclosing our Rules and Regulations which sets forth the water rates and service charges.
