Dear Mr. Fletcher:

In answer to your letter regarding the restoration of the museum at Julian, California, the amount of material required will be:

- ✓ 2,700 lineal feet of 1/2 in. round reinforced steel *SB 1 in*
- ✓ 200 lineal feet of 7/8 in. round reinforced steel *mm*
- ✓ 420 lineal feet of 1/4 in. round reinforced steel, *SB*
- ✓ 1,000 sq. ft. of 6in. by 6in. 10 gauge reinforced wire mesh *mm 6x6 size*
- 210 bags of cement.

This material will build the walls of the Number 2 Display Room.

You will be pleased to know that the Lions Club of Julian have donated 2,000 hours of labor to do the building.

Dear Colonel Fletcher:

Concerning the discussions we have had previously about the installation of a small sewage disposal plant to serve approximately twenty families in the Helix lake area, it seems to me that such a project is impractical. I understand that your engineer has estimated the cost to each of the families to be approximately \$1300 for the installation of the necessary collection lines and plant. This cost is not a bit higher than I would expect, but it does seem to me that it is higher than you could reasonably expect the property owners to be willing to undertake.

Therefore, I must say that in my opinion the project as previously outlined seems to be impractical.
