

Replying to your letter of October 4th:

I shall be glad to meet you in San Diego October 15th, on "ednesday morning, and proceed to the work for final inspection.

The present water supply is small, and it will take a considerable time to fill the syphone. For this reason, Mr. Bartl, the Superintendent Engineer, has frequently suggested that you authorize him to gradully fill the syphon, at the rate of two or three feet idditional head per day. In that case, the syphone can b readily filled on the date of your arrival, and would be ready for a final test of leakage in two or threedays. Otherwise, it would take longer.

You will understand that we are especially anxious to pu this syphon into service promptly, and everything that ou can reasonably do to hasten matters will be apprecited. In so far as you or your representative are put t extra expense in inspecting and being present durin this gradual refilling, would seem to me to be a prope extra.charge. So if you could send me some one befor the 15th to supervise refilling the line, I should thinkit would be advisable.
