In answer to your letter of the 14th. and confirming our conversation of December 13th. I wish to state as regards to both of the following claims against the San Bernardino County Saving Bank, Claim #572 of Della M. Berry and claim #825 of Mr. and Mrs. A. G. Rose, that I have never received directly or indirectly any money to be used for my own account for the purchase of these accounts.

I purchased these two accounts in the regular way as per instructions given by C. F. Pitts. Very shortly after their purchase Pitts told me that the Banking Dep't. would not honor the assignment of these two accounts, as there had been a complaint filed and until such time as this was cleared up he could not pay me my commission which I had earned for picking up these accounts. I saw Pitts several times after this and he on each of these occasions told me that these assignments had never been accepted by the Banking Dep't. consequently I have never received any money for my work on them.
