Dear Professor Szilard:

In reply to your letter I would like to say that there is one injection device for vaccinia produced by AB Relax, Odengatan 39, Stockholm. It is called Vaccinator for mass vaccination purposes.

But recalling our conversation you want a "pistol" by which you give one injection at a time. I have investigated the German market but the gadgets manufactured are for mass-vaccination (subcutaneous).

Left is the atropine-filled single-use gadget for military purposes but I am little hesitant about its conversion to other drugs.

I have had this inquiry to several leading the health authorities, but they cannot give more information than what is written above.

Will you be in Geneva at next EFBO-meeting?
