Your favor of the 10th came to my hands yesterday—

I have been looking over my copy of General Orders of the Army at Ficoachrogo in 1796. in hopes of finding something which might be of use to your family; but find nothing; and I have no other papers or Memoranda of that date to which I can refer for the purpose— I have a distinct recollection of Col. Bond, as a valuable Officer, and of his lamented death— but can testify to no circumstances which can be of use in establishing the Claim which the Family propose to institute

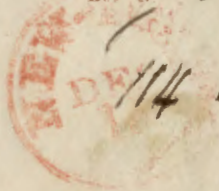
