I have not received any notice of

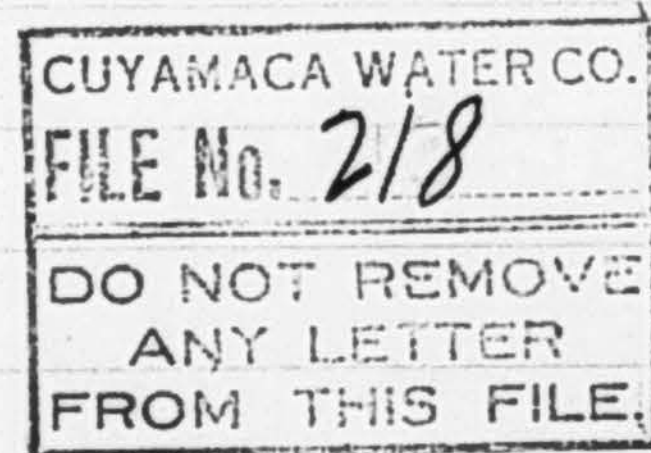
water bills nor has the matter ever

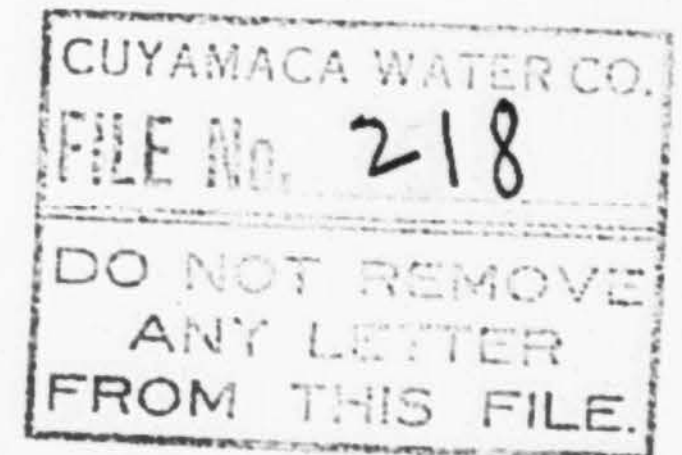

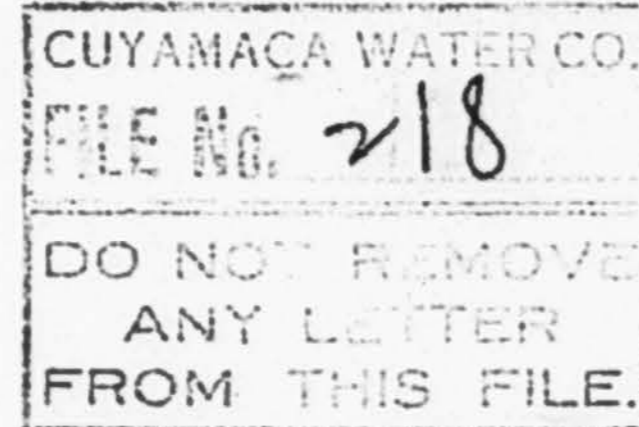

Dear Sir:

Answering your letter of October 23rd, 1915, relative to the water being turned off and meter taken out, which supplies the Murray house located in El Cajon Acres No. 2, we were not aware of any arrangement being made with Mr. Stanley Hofflund or any other person as to the use of water, however commencing November 1, 1915 we will have to charge you with all water shown on your meter at twenty-five cents per thousand gallons with a monthly minimum charge of \$1.25. These bills will be mailed to you and must be paid between the first and tenth of the following month in which the water is furnished as per our rules a copy of which is being enclosed herewith.

We have instructed our Superintendent to replace and connect up the meters and turn on the water - this undoubtedly will be attended to today.
