Thank you for taking the time to complete the enclosed form. The Work Furlough Center would like to take this opportunity to explain our program and hopefully answer any questions regarding the employment of a Work Furlough Resident. We do not wish to inconvenience you further but we believe that by expressing some of the program requirements we may answer any questions you may have and save you time in the future.

Schedule Changes

In the event that the resident's work schedule changes (including overtime) please notify the facility in writing via fax or a letter written on company letterhead of the dates and time in order for staff to make the appropriate arrangements. Please note, any fax received after 4pm Monday-Friday will not be reviewed until the following business day. We understand that advanced notice may not always be possible and the facility will accept confirmation of the schedule change before or after the resident is needed to work.

Changes in Work Location

If the resident is needed to change his/her work location he/she will be required to call the facility to report the movement. The resident is not allowed to leave the work site for lunch.

On-Site and Telephone Verification


The facility staff is required to visit the resident at least once every two weeks. We attempt to make this visit as discreet and unobtrusive as possible. Under normal circumstances, you will not be required to be present during these checks. The facility is also required to complete a telephonic check at least once a week. During these checks staff will need to speak to the contact person on file or to the resident. Please note, due to privacy restrictions staff must protect the residents confidentiality and is not permitted to speak to anyone regarding the resident's criminal history or participation in the Work Furlough Program.

Driving

The resident is not permitted to drive any vehicle without staff approval. Additionally, the resident is not permitted to receive transportation in a private vehicle (this includes a company vehicle) without staff approval.

We appreciate your time and attention in this matter. It is our intent to work with the employer to make the employment of our residents as unobtrusive as possible. Please feel free to contact Calvin Herbin, Juan Araiza or myself at (619) 232-8600 with any questions or concerns.


Hopefully there is something that can still be done to help you regarding the injustice that has been done to you.

Well ol' friend, don't want to be the one to say I told you so, but I think we both knew there was a good chance they wouldn't like me given that news interview to Channel 39. Just think how they must have felt having a convicted felon talking to the news media about police brutality.

How embarrassed they must have been. The inmates at work furlough all seen me and was laughing up a storm. Mayor Waters AKA King George was going to his car when I was being interviewed and also that Dump Truck City attorney George Esiven was outside. Any way they called the Probation Department, and they contacted the work furlough people and told them to give me a rule violation for "unauthorized communications" and not reporting my "whereabouts" anyway that following Monday Oct. 21st 02 I had my kangaroo hearing at the Probation Department. Since "I wasn't remorseful" for speaking badly about their fucked up just-us system of justice I was found guilty as charged, and sent

To the County Jail To finish my sentence
~~for~~ committing that most outrageous and hide-
ous crime of wearing a bandolier of "live"
ammunition. Surely they didn't expect me
to wear a bandolier with dummy rounds did
they? What were they afraid of? Guess they
didn't like my symbolic symbol did they?

You and I know that if
I had been telling the news media that they
were really good cops, and that the poll
conducted by the task force was flawed,
and inaccurate, and that this mostly all
white police force was being falsely accused
by the Mexican community, I wouldn't be
here whatsoever, correct! Shame shame
on me for NOT being corrupted

I hope you and the family
have a merry X-mas and drink a cold
beer on New Years for me. Time is
going fast for me anyway. Been doing that
work out thing. Berine from the Peace and
Freedom Party said that the Committee on
Humanity and Diversity is going to present me
with an award for my work against Police
Brutality to the City of National City
at the first Council meeting in January 03.

That's nice of them. Well I haven't seen nothing in the San Diego Union about "Nick The Trick" saying when their going to get down to takeing care of that message the voters gave them 68% said they want a Police Review Board. Well we will just have to wait a little while and see what "Nick The Trick" what kind of Trick he's got Planned if any.

Just dropping you a few lines
to let ya know what's up. Been transferred
from South County to North County Vista
Jail. Was at George Bailey in San Diego
witnessed a Deputy pounding an inmates
head into the concrete, while other deputies
had arms and legs restrained. Anyway had
(18) other inmates as witness. Had them
give their names and booking numbers. The
next day when they gave me a formal
complaint form for internal affairs, they
transferred me out, up to here. Be here
(2) weeks on Feb 25th. They didn't like me
getting inmates to speak out about their brutality,
guess they figure it's best to keep me
away so I can't tell the witness what they
will be doing!

Got a date for Sheriff's
Parole. March 20th. Don't know if I'll
get it, but no harm in trying. Anyway

Their address is— Board of Parole Commissioners
900 Cottonwood Ave Santee, Ca 92071, If you
have time from your schedule, I would
be most appreciative if you could send
a letter encouraging parole. I'll have
already served $\frac{1}{2}$ of sentence. Hope
everything is going good for you and your
family. Been watching the news alot. The
price of gas is going to sky rocket if
we go to war. This so-called President
isn't going to be happy intill he has
control of all the oil in the middle east
No matter how many innocent women and
children are murdered by his war hawks,
and their killing machines, the military.
How's Mark doing? Hope
he still driving a truck. When you see him
tell him to keep the speed down and
the heavy foot off the gas and he will
always have a career job in the trucking
industry.

Going to close now. Keep
up the struggle.
