My dear Mr. Fletcher:

I have been trying to prepare a map in this Office showing the true location of the various works and proposed works on the El Capitan Reservation. I have used Land Office maps, the Hamilton Survey of the reservoir and our own and maps of the Conejos reservoir and flume. I have also attempted to use some of the old maps furnished by your Company and your predecessors and maps furnished by our field force, in order to accurately locate the Cuyamaca flume.

I do not find any set of field notes or any land ties that will enable me to accurately locate this, and I am writing for the purpose of ascertaining whether you have in your office any such field notes; that is, the alignment of the flume with the proper land ties. If you have such, I would very much appreciate a copy in order that I may prepare such a map as above mentioned.
