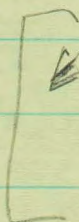


Dear Dr. Szilard:

the number of inhabitants determines the size of a city for such purposes. And perhaps there ought to be a list of all American and Russian cities on record which is accepted as authentic by both governments, and which gives the number of inhabitants for each city. Moreover, there ought to be an understanding that any city which is to be demolished with the authorisation of either government would be given adequate warning to permit its orderly evacuation.

I propose that, until such time as it is possible for the two governments to prepare an authorised list, the list of the cities attached to this memorandum which I have compiled from the best data available to me, serve in lieu of such authorised list.
