As I stated to you we have no problem with a fire inspection of our premises, but there is a deep <sup>feeling of a</sup> concern of possible "political harassment" by the city of N.C. because of the following reasons:

- (1) The city of N.C. has not inspected our premises in the last 5-7 years.
- (2) The current inspection was requested 3 days after our organization filed a \$74,500 complaint against the city for rights violations in the low-rider issue.

While it is possible that the <sup>Fire Rpt's</sup> ~~the~~ request for a fire inspection right after we filed our complaint might be coincidental, it is our org. position that our concerns are not based on unfounded feeling but on the following facts:

- (1) Our organization has apprehended police infiltrators on our premises.
- (2) Our organization has had files missing
- (3) The Morgan Administration in the past has been accused of alleged spying by the N.C. city Clerk.
- (4) The F.B.I. has had our organization under surveillance as proved by the 200 pg. packet received under the Freedom of Information.

It is our organization position that in granting the power of attorney to you that you state to the Fire Chief that the only way that we will grant permission to inspect our premises is if the following stipulation are met + agreed to by the NC. Fire Dept.

- (1) That they prove to your satisfaction that this inspection is part of a systematic procedure of inspecting all business establishments under their jurisdiction.

7. Retail stores and markets require 1 2A-10BC type extinguisher for each 3,000 sq. ft. of floor area. Travel distance not to exceed 100 feet. Additional extinguishers may be required for electrical panel and refrigeration rooms. UFC 13.301

8. Office buildings, general offices, banks, police stations requires 1 2A-10BC type extinguisher for each 5,000 sq. ft. of floor area. Travel distance not to exceed 100 feet. UFC 13.301
9. Factories and workshops using combustible materials require a minimum of 1 2A-10BC type extinguisher. Travel distance not to exceed 75 feet. UFC 13.301
10. Electronic equipment and appliance repair shops require a minimum of 1 2A-10BC type extinguisher. Travel distance not to exceed 75 feet. UFC 13.301

1. One 2A-10BC type extinguisher for each 3,000 sq. ft. of floor area. Travel distance not to exceed 100 feet to reach an extinguisher. UFC 13.301

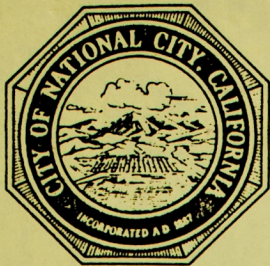

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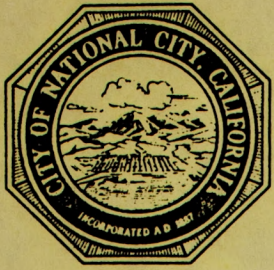

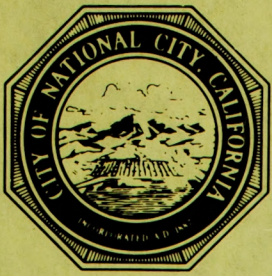
