Perhaps you have not heard that Mr. C.F.Pitts has passed away. I am trying to straighten out his matters, and it was through me that Mr. Frank Lynch furnished the funds and purchased the San Bernardino County Savings bank's claims.

I have before me a letter of November 21, 1936 to Mr. Dempster McKee, First National Bank Bldg., San Diego. I also have before me a receipt in favor of C.F.Pitts dated October 18, 1935 under the signature of Bernard S.Evans, your representative; claim #825 in the original amount of \$3055.09 executed by Mrs. A.G.Rose in favor of Frank Lynch dated October 11, 1935; also assignment of claim #572 in the original amount of \$604.66 executed by Adella M.Barry in favor of Frank Lynch dated October 11, 1935, with notation that these assignments are in your possession. Also letter of October 21, 1935 wherein B.S.Evans states that claim #572 has been registered on your books showing Frank Lynch as the assignes. Also letter of October 23, 1935 addressed to C.F.Pitts showing that the above assignments have been entered on your records showing the address of Frank Lynch as 1925 "K" Street, San Diego.



Further, with reference to the contents of your letter, as I explained very carefully to Mr. McKee when he was here with Mr. Lynch, Junior, the two accounts in question had never been changed on the claim book or on the records in this office, and therefore, the matter in regard to certain letters signed by Mr. Evans, my predecessor, is something that I have no control over, and evidently the action of Mr. Evans was one not authorized.

We have in our files a letter from the Banking Department attorneys, which reads - "it is the opinion of this office that the signatures of both parties are necessary for the transfer of such a claim".

The claim books of the San Bernardino County Savings Bank are open for your examination, inasmuch as you are interested in the transaction, and you can see from personal examination that the said records have never been changed to read other than the original depositors. Pencil notations were made on the books, but they were evidently placed thereon by Mr. Evans, but these had been erased.


