LAPOP (Latin American Public Opinion Project) Licensing Agreement for AmericasBarometer Data Sets

Content Description

The "Licensed Materials" consist of public opinion surveys carried out by the Latin American Public Opinion project as part of its AmericasBarometer series. The sample sizes, county coverage and questionnaire content will vary from survey wave to wave. Normally, a new wave is conducted every two years, but this is not guaranteed as it depends on grant and contract funding to the Latin American Public Opinion Project. The license does not cover special purpose samples that may be carried out from time-to-time, even when those are listed on the LAPOP web site (www.LapopSurveys.org).

License

Each license runs for one year, starting the date the payment is received. During that period of time, the institution purchasing the license may download the data files for the AmericasBarometer Survey. There are four classes of license:

D. Rest of World	A single year of AmericasBarometer Surveys (e.g., 2004, 2006), year to be selected by institution applying for a license	

Authorized Users, Licensees and Authentication:

The "Licensee" is the Institution that licenses the Licensed Materials from Vanderbilt and pays the subscription fee.

"Authorized Users" shall be defined as:

- Full and part time students and employees (including faculty, staff, affiliated researchers and independent contractors) and other visiting researchers and walk-in patrons, regardless of the physical location of such persons.

Licensors will provide the Licensee an institutional username and password for use by the Licensee and its Authorized Users. The username and password will allow for unlimited simultaneous users. The username and password will expire upon termination of the agreement.

Permitted uses:

Permitted uses for Licensees and Authorized Users.

- Retrieve Licensed Materials
- Print, download, and digitally copy Licensed Materials
- Authorized Users shall be permitted to extract or use information contained in the database for educational, scientific, or research purposes, such as extraction, manipulation and recombination of information for the purpose of illustration, explanation, example, comment, criticism, teaching, research, or analysis.
- Use a reasonable portion of the Licensed Materials in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by their institution, including use for electronic reserves.
- Use a reasonable portion of the Licensed Materials in the preparation of course packs or other educational materials.
- Provide electronic links to the Licensed Materials from the Licensees Web pages, catalogs, and course management systems.
- Nothing in this agreement shall limit the Licensee's or its Authorized Users' rights consistent with U.S. copyright law.
- Scholarly Sharing. Authorized Users may transmit to a third party in hard copy or electronically, minimal, insubstantial amounts of the Licensed Materials for personal use or scholarly, educational, or scientific research or professional use but in no case for resale or commercial purposes. **IN NO CASE CAN DATA SETS THEMSELVES BE TRANSFERRED TO A THIRD PARTY.**

Additional permitted uses

- Licensee and Authorized Users may make such local digital copies of the Licensed Materials as are necessary to ensure efficient use by Authorized Users by appropriate browser or other software.
- Licensee may mount the data sets purchased under this agreement on its protected local network, accessible only by Authorized Users.

Prohibited uses

- Transmit to a third party, in hard copy or electronically, any portion of the Licensed Materials, except as allowed in the permitted uses section of this license.
- Licensee may not fulfill requests from other institutions, a practice commonly called Interlibrary Loan. It may not distribute the data to any third party, third parties defined as individuals or institutions who do not hold a valid LAPOP license as described in this document.
- No commercial use of the Licensed Materials is permitted.

Human Subject Protection Clause

- All LAPOP data sets distributed via this agreement have been collected in conformance with U.S. Federal Human Subjects protection regulations, as implemented by the Vanderbilt University Institutional Review Board.
