

## **Honorary Alumni of UCSD established**

A group of San Diegans interested in furthering the growth and development of the University of California campus here have created an organization to be known as "Honorary Alumni of UCSD," Chancellor Herbert York announced today.

The first project of the group is to assist in the establishment of undergraduate student scholarships for the first freshman class of UCSD expected to number more than 150 in the Fall semester of 1964. Already the fund totals over \$1,500, Chancellor York said. He also noted that The Regents of the University have agreed to match contributions to the scholarship fund, up to a total of \$5,000. This matching concept, in keeping with the scholarship matching fund policy established by The Regents in 1934, applies to all campuses of the University of California.

Preliminary organization of the "Honorary Alumni" is being formulated by a volunteer guidance committee until formal arrangements are completed. Serving with this group are Mr. Tom Ham, Mr. Charles Catlin, La Jolla, and Mrs. R. L. Cote, San Diego.

The basic purpose of the group is to provide alumni and persons having a special interest in the campus an opportunity to contribute to the growth of UCSD. Additional service projects will be initiated by the "Honorary Alumni" as the organization expands.
