

## **UCSD appoints Mary Gagliardo new director of development for student affairs**

Mary Gagliardo has been appointed to the new position of director of development for student affairs at the University of California, San Diego (UCSD).

Gagliardo, a graduate of State University of New York at Albany and the University of Arizona, will have primary responsibility for planning and implementing a fund raising program for student affairs at UCSD. This will include fund raising efforts for undergraduate scholarships and international education programs.

Prior to her appointment at UCSD, Gagliardo was director of development for the School of Business Administration and Economics at California State University, Fullerton. Previously, she worked at California State University, Long Beach (CSULB), as director of school relations and university outreach, then as director of development for academic affairs, and subsequently as director of foundation and corporate relations. Gagliardo also served as assistant director of school and college relations for UC Irvine.

At CSULB, Gagliardo was successful in obtaining gifts to fund a molecular biology laboratory, summer orientation programs for minority students, and early student outreach efforts. She also launched the Department of Chemistry's first annual corporate campaign and initiated its first out-of-state fund raising activities. At Cal State Fullerton, she organized a development board headed by Frank P. Stanek, president of MCA Enterprises International.
