RE: Visit of Senator Edward Kennedy to UC San Diego

WHEN: 10 a.m. Friday, November 30

Senator Edward Kennedy is scheduled to give a one-hour talk with questions and answers on national health care at 10 a.m. Friday, November 30, at the University of California, San Diego.

As of yet we do not know where on the campus the senator will speak. His staff is to make that decision and they have indicated it will not be made until the middle of November. Because of this, tickets to the talk (free with a limit of two per person) will be available on Monday, November 26, at the UCSD Central Box Office in the Student Center.

Provisions will be made for local and national press coverage. It appears that Senator Kennedy's schedule will not allow for a press conference while at UC San Diego.

The Senator's appearance at UC San Diego is to be jointly sponsored by the Health Sciences Advisory Program, an arm of Career Planning and Placement, and the Health Experience Learning Program, a student-run pre-med organization on campus.
