"By an appropriate adjustment of the interval, we have been able to keep a pigeon responding continuously for 1500 hours - that is, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for approximately 2 months. Wendell Levi¹ has advanced the thesis that pigeons never sleep (roosting is merely a precautionary device against blind flying), and the statement seems to be confirmed by experiments of the present sort."

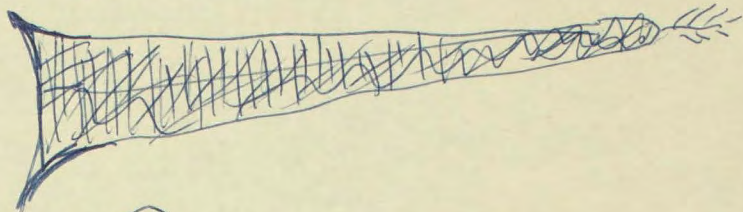

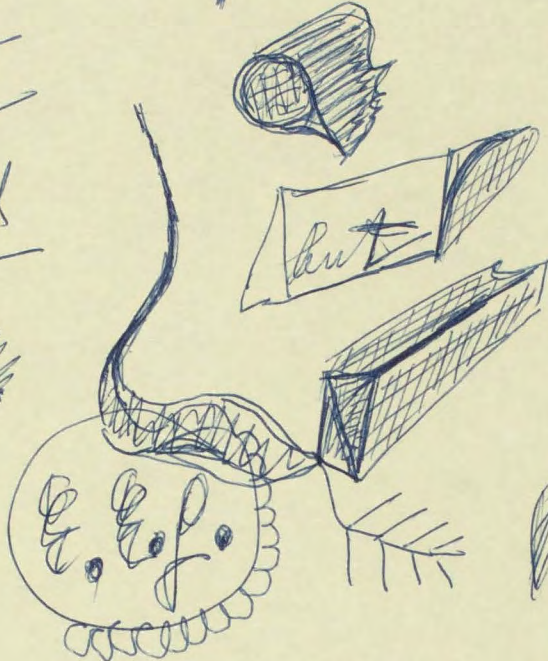

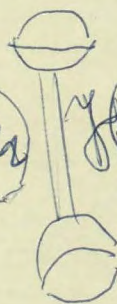
