

Five young musicians from the La Mesa-El Cajon area will appear March 21 with the Wind Ensemble

Five young musicians from the La Mesa-El Cajon area will appear at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla, on Wednesday night, March 21, when the Wind Ensemble from the University of California, Los Angeles, presents a program of band music.

Led by Clarence Sawhill, Professor of Music at UCLA, the group of 44 players includes 34 who were with the UCLA Concert Band on its triumphant European tour last year.

The soloists will include Antoinette Mizisin, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Kizisin in Hayon's Oboe Concerto. Miss Mizisin has played for the past two summers with the San Diego Symphony Orchestra. She is a sophomore at UCLA majoring in music.

Kenneth Schei, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ben Schei will play a trumpet solo. Also a sophomore at UCLA and a music major, Mr. Schei has had 11 years of study on the trumpet, and has played with the Grossmont High School Band and Orchestra, the San Diego Civic Youth Orchestra, All Southern California High School Band, and the UCLA Bands and Orchestra.

Others appearing in the concert will be the brothers, Tom and Ward Beck, sons of Mr. and Mrs. William Beck both clarinet players. Mr. Tom Beck is an English major at UCLA, Mr. Ward Beck is a Music major.

Playing in the percussion section will be Steve Davis.

The appearance of the Wind Ensemble is sponsored by the University's Committee for Intercampus Arts Exchange. Tickets are \$2.00 general admission; \$1.00 for students. Tickets are available at the Art Center in La Jolla, at University Extension, 1221 Fourth Avenue, San Diego and at the Cashier's Office on the San Diego campus.

The program will include Cherubini's "Anacreon," the Hayons Oboe Concerto, Persichetti's Symphony for Band, a trumpet solo by Mr. Schei, Debussy's Petite Suite, and selections from Gershwin's "Porgy and Bass". It will end with selected marches.
