

Graduates of 1963 to be honored by Chancellor & Mrs. York

Twelve 1963 graduates of the University of California's San Diego campus will be honored by Chancellor and Mrs. Herbert York and the San Diego faculty at a commencement reception Saturday, June 1, at University House.
