

Dave Mason to perform

Singer-songwriter Dave Mason will perform at 7:30 p.m. and 11 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 27, in the Main Gym at the University of California, San Diego. Mason's special guest will be Jerry Riopelle and the Double Shuffle Band.

Tickets to the concert cost \$6.75 in advance for UC San Diego students and \$7.75 for the general public and at the door. Tickets are available at Selectaseat outlets and at the UCSD Central Box Office.

Mason began his recording career with Traffic, a group which he formed with Stevie Winwood, Jim Capaldi and Chris Wood. Mason's song, "Feelin' Alright," originally recorded by Traffic, has been recorded by numerous other groups and artists and is considered to be a rock-and-roll classic.

In 1969 Mason left Traffic and undertook several projects on his own. He toured with Delaney and Bonnie and Friends and with Derek and the Dominoes, and he recorded his first solo album.

After a brief reunion with Traffic, which resulted in a live recording of the group's concerts, Mason resumed his solo career and to date he has recorded eight albums on his own, including his latest release, "Mariposa de Oro."
