BY - LAWS

Of the San Diego Marine Biological Association.

- /. The undersigned hereby form themselves into an organization to be called the Marine Biological Association of San Diego, for the purpose of securing the foundation and endowment of a scientific institution to be known as the San Diego Marine Biological Institution.
- 2. The general purposes of the institution shall be to carry on a biological and hydrographic survey of the waters of the Pacific Ocean adjacent to the coast of Southern California, to build and maintain a public aquarium and museum, and to prosecute such other kindred undertakings as the Board of Trustees may from time to time deem it wise to enter upon.
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- 7. There shall be no administen for annual dues of required of the members of this association.
- 8. Fifteen members of the association shall constitute a quorum.
- 9. The poore of Trustees may at any time fix = limit to the ====== members of the association, provided however, that this limit shall never be less than the charter membership of the association.

MARINE BIOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION OF SAN DIEGO, A CORPORATION.

I.

The name and purpose of this corporation are those set out in its Articles of Incorporation.

The officers of this corporation shall be a President, Vice-President, Scientific Director, Secretary and Treasurer.

III.

The officers of this corporation shall be elected at its regular annual meeting, which shall be held on the second Tuesday of July of each year, at ten o'clock A.M.; and it shall not be necessary to give any notice of such annual meeting.

The officers shall hold office for one year and until their successors shall have been duly elected.

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The Board of Directors shall have power to fill vacancies in the offices, arising from any cause. It shall be their duty to carry out the purpose of this corporation. They shall have full control of all funds of the corporation, and the management of the institution. They shall make a full report of all moneys received and disbursed and of the affairs of the institution at each annual meeting. They shall have power to elect new members of the corporation, a majority of the Directors being requisite for such election.

The President and Vice-President, or any three members of the Board shall have the power to call a special meeting of the Board, or of the members of the corporation at any time, by depositing in the United States Post-Office at San Diego, a notice addressed to each member of the Board or of the corporation, postage thereon being prepaid, two days before said meeting;

and special meetings of the members of the corporation may be called on the written request of one-half of the members of the Association, and like notice of said meeting shall be given.

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VI.

These By-Laws may be amended by two-thirds vote at any regular or special meeting of the members of the corporation, notice of the proposed amendment having been mailed to each member of the corporation at least fifteen (15) days before the meeting at which a vote on said amendment is to be taken, or in the manner provided by the general laws of the State of California.

The foregoing by-laws are hereby adopted and approved this 23rd day of May, 1904.
