The Parsons Dance Company, known for the wit and creativity of its choreography, will perform at 8 p.m. Sunday, Jan. 9, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

Artistic director David Parsons has created 26 works for the Parsons Dance Company, which was founded in 1987. Parsons also has choreographed works for the Paul Taylor Dance Company and the American Ballet Theater, among others. His works have been performed by such companies as the famed Feld Ballet, the Paris Opera Ballet and the English National Ballet.

Also a dancer, Parsons' performances with the eight-member ensemble has been lauded by audiences and critics. The ensemble's dancing style has been praised for its athleticism and ability to translate movement into meaning, "without sacrificing one bit of technique," according to reviewer Amy Rumizen-Cohen of the Buffalo News.
