

All-Cal Tennis Tournament held here

February 4, 1970

The University of California, San Diego will host the annual All-Cal Tennis Tournament Friday and Saturday, February 6 and 7, on the UCSD campus. In addition to UCSD, entries include teams from Berkeley, Santa Cruz, Davis, Santa Barbara, Irvine and Riverside.

Matches are scheduled to begin at 8:00 a.m. each day on the John Muir Courts just off North Torrey Pines Road. Each campus will enter six singles and three doubles ranked according to ability. Separate elimination tournaments are scheduled for each rank, with contestants in each group separated into "A" and "B" flights on the basis of first round results.

The tournament team championship will be determined on the basis of total team points earned, with one point awarded for each match win in any group and either flight. Individual awards will go to "A" flight winners, "A" flight runners up, and "B" flight winners in each grouping. Matches will be two out of three sets.

Admission to the tournament is free.
