

10-Kilometer Run

The second annual UCSD 10-Kilometer Run is being held on Saturday, May 31, at the University of California, San Diego.

The run, sponsored by the UC San Diego Women's Caucus, will begin at 8 a.m. in the School of Medicine parking lot on Gilman Drive. The 6.2-mile course circles the campus and includes one steep hill behind the Central University Library.

Entry forms are available at various sporting goods stores and from Women's Caucus members. Registration costs \$6 before May 31 and \$8 the morning of the run, from 5:30-7 a.m. T-shirts will be handed out to all entrants the day of the event. The top three finishers in each division will receive awards and race results will be mailed to all finishers.
