

The Cleveland String Quartet will perform

The Cleveland String Quartet will perform at 8 p.m. Wednesday, April 14, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

The quartet was formed in 1969 and takes its name from the Cleveland Institute of Music where its members were artists-in-residence. The members have all won prizes in international competition and are regulars at the summer Marlboro Music Festivals.

Their program at UC San Diego will include "Quartet No.1 in B Minor, Opus 50" by Prokofiev, "Quartet in F Major, Opus 3, No.5" by Hayden and "Quartet in B Flat Major, Opus 130" by Beethoven.
