

The Regents and the President of UC will honor Herbert York, first Chancellor of the University, with a reception on November 6

The Regents and the President of the University of California will honor Herbert York, first Chancellor of the University's San Diego campus, with a reception on Monday afternoon, November 6.

The event will be held in the Library patio on the San Diego campus from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. President and Mrs. Clark Kerr and Chancellor and Mrs. York will receive guests. Refreshments will be served.

At the same time, the Chancellor's offices, in room 112 Scripps Building, will be open to the public.

Students and staff of the San Diego campus, as well as community leaders will attend the reception, which will also be open to the public.

Chancellor York officially took office on July 1, 1961. He came to San Diego from Washington, where he had served three years as Director of Defense Research and Planning under President Eisenhower and President Kennedy.

The informal reception has been planned instead of a formal inaugural reception. On Monday evening, President and Mrs. Kerr will honor Chancellor and Mrs. York with a small dinner at the La Jolla Beach and Tennis Club. The guest list will consist of members of the faculty and staff of the San Diego campus.
