

Assemblyman John Stull speaks on environmental legislation

State Assemblyman John Stull of Leucadia will talk on "The Environmental Crisis" at 7:00 p.m., Friday, March 6, in Room 2622, Undergraduate Sciences Building at the University of California, San Diego. The talk is free and open to the public.

Stull, who was elected to the 80th district seat of the California State Assembly in 1966, will discuss the bills pending before the legislature dealing with environmental control and pollution. His talk is being sponsored by the UCSD Young Republicans.

Assemblyman Stull received a B.A. degree from the University of Iowa and came to California in 1944. He served for 20 years in the Navy and retired with the rank of Commander. He and his wife have one daughter who attends Whittier College.
