

Dr. Reinhard Lettau will present the fourth PILS lecture

Reinhard Lettau, professor of German literature at the University of California, San Diego, will present the fourth lecture in the Professors' Inaugural Lecture Series at 4:15 p.m., Thursday, November 14, in the Humanities-Library Auditorium, Revelle College campus. His topic will be "Poetry--After Auschwitz?".

Dr. Lettau attended the University of Heidelberg, Germany, and Yale University. He received his Ph.D. degree from Harvard University where he received a teaching fellowship. He then held assistant and associate professorships at Smith College, and was a guest lecturer at Mount Holyoke College and the University of Massachusetts. He joined the University of California, San Diego, last year.

The lecture will be free and open to the public.
