

Laser technology arts lecture by John Mizelle set

"Laser Technology and the Arts," a seminar by University of California, San Diego graduate student John Mizelle will be presented at noon, Thursday, November 18, in the Art Gallery, Matthews Campus.

The presentation will define what a laser light is, its special qualities, and demonstrate use of laser technique in the arts.

Mizelle has studied with Larry Austin, David Tudor, and Karl Stockhausen, and was associated with laser sculptor Tom Fresh. He is interested in projects combining music, art, and technology. He received his B.A. from Sacramento State College and his M.A. from UC Davis. He is presently working on his Ph.D. at UCSD. He has had extensive training in composition of music and technological music performance. His works have been played in the United States and Canada.
