GOLDEN TRIANGLE ROTARY CLUB HOSTS CAFE AT UCSD

The Golden Triangle Rotary Club will host the International Cafe at the University of California, San Diego International Center, Friday, Jan. 22, from 11:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m.

The International Cafe is a weekly Friday luncheon, which is one of the many programs sponsored by the UCSD International Center. The purpose of the Cafe is to provide an informal meeting place for UCSD's international community of students and faculty, as well as others interested in international cultural exchange.

More than 200 people attend the Cafe each week. Each Cafe is sponsored by a different community organization or campus department or organization. The sponsor contributes both time and money. These sponsorships, with proceeds from the luncheon cost of \$1.50 per person, enable the Cafe to be self-supporting. During the luncheon, members of the hosting group meet guests, serve the food and socialize with attendees.

The International Cafe was initiated over six years ago. Community organizations such as the Golden Triangle Rotary Club frequently sponsor the Cafe because of their emphasis on international activities and services as part of their service programs.
