Two special "career" days, open to students from all San Diego college and university campuses, have been scheduled at the University of California, San Diego.

The two events are UCSD MBA Day, scheduled for Monday, October 10, and UCSD Pre-law Day, scheduled for Tuesday, November 8. Both events will be held from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. around the Student Center Hump near the gymnasium. Both events are under the direction of the UCSD Career Planning and Placement Office.

At UCSD MBA Day, admissions representatives from over 30 business and management schools will be available to answer questions and distribute materials. In addition, several other business and economic-related activities will be presented.

Representatives from Cornell, Dartmouth, New York University, San Diego State University, Berkeley, UCLA, University of Chicago, University of Michigan, USIU, USC and the University of San Diego are among those expected to attend. The Economics & Management Science Student Association (EMSSA) and the Society for the Advancement of Management (SAM) are co-sponsors of the October 10th event with Career Planning and Placement.

At UCSD Pre-law Day, admissions representatives from law schools from across the nation will be available to answer questions and to distribute application materials. Other law-related activities are also planned.

The November 8th event is co-sponsored with Humanities and Social Sciences Career Services and the Pre-law Education Association (PLEA).
