

Federated Women's League of University City presents check to Library

The Federated Women's League of University City recently presented a check for the amount of \$360.20 to the Library of the University of California, San Diego.

The donation consisted of the proceeds of a fashion show given by the League on March 9. The show, "Vive le Spring," was held at the Atlantis Restaurant.

Melvin J. Voigt, University librarian, said the money would be put in a fund for books on the humanities and that each book purchased with money from the donation would have a marker placed in it, naming the League as the donor.

The Federated Women's League of University City was organized in 1965. The League's civic and primary purpose is to promote the welfare of the community at large and its youth in particular.

The League has won the President's Award in the San Diego district for their help to the library. They also donate money for scholarships.
