Dear Arthur:

I have rather an involved request.

The Superintendent of the Cabrillo National Monument was one of the honored guests at a dinner attended by Senator Ed Fletcher and myself and other officials. The Senator spoke of the legislature passing those Cabrillo Resolutions and of his receiving the embossed invitation or something to the Premier of Portugal. I think this latter was from the Senate but it could be that the Assembly sent one also. I recall that I acted as go-between from Fletcher to Senator Kraft and Assemblyman Cloyed, etc.

After a three-way conversation, etc., the Superintendent asked Fletcher and me if he couldn't get copies of the Resolutions referred to above, as well as illuminated or other Memorial Resolutions transmitted to Premier Salazar at Lisbon.

So the object of this is to request that you mail the following, direct:

- 1 - Assembly Resolution in final form.
- 2 - Senate Resolution in final form.
- 3 - Assembly Memorializing Resolution, if any.
- 4 - Senate Memorializing Resolution.
