



Please find attached three copies of the above patrol report submitted by Mr. A. Didlick, A.D.O. Comments I wish to make are as follows :-

THE ECONOMY OF THE AREA:

I will discuss with the Co-operatives Officer at Samarai the reasons for the drop in the standards of services provided by Co-operative Stores along the Suau Coast.

The poor tax collection of the Suau Council is well known to officers at District Headquarters. This particular Council spends most of its tax money on its infrastructure and in maintaining the Council boat. Consequently, there is little left to enable Capital Works projects to be put into the villages. Thus, as there is nothing done, the people are understandably reluctant to pay tax in later years.

ATTITUDE TOWARDS LOCAL GOVERNMENT

The picture Mr. Didlick paints is a disturbing one but is unfortunately true. For the government to involve itself in the affairs of this Council is likely to lead to resentment and major difficulties.

SITUATION REPORT NO. 1.

The attitude taken by the Mod wa people is symptomatic of a feeling of frustration experienced by many people in the Suau Council area, with what they see as failure by that Council to do anything constructive in the villages.

I have no further comments to make. For your comments and on forwarding please.

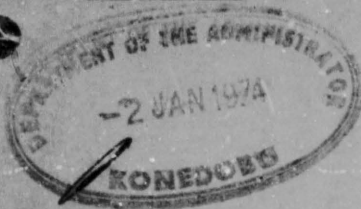
