

Friends of the Library book sale

April 21, 1980

A small mountain of books -- nearly 8,000 in all -- will be on sale during the eighth annual Friends of the UCSD Library book sale Saturday, May 3, at the University of California, San Diego.

The sale will begin at 10 a.m. in front of the Central University Library. The books, nearly all clothbound, will be available at very reasonable prices with the majority at less than one dollar per volume.

All of the books will be put out for selection during the first three hours of the sale so buyers should come early for the best selection. According to Lawrence McGilvery, a member of the Friends board of directors and chairman of this year's event, the one-day sale will feature an unusually fine selection of general and scholarly works on all subjects including literature, history, social sciences and physical sciences.

Many of the books have been donated to the Friends by the community specifically for the sale. Others are owned by the library but are no longer needed in the collection. Profits from the sale will benefit the UC San Diego libraries.
