

Segre will give the first of an All-University Lecture Series on the San Diego campus on March 29

Emilio Segre, Nobel prize winner in physics, will give the first of an All-University Lecture Series on the San Diego campus of the University of California at 4:15 p.m. Thursday, March 29.

Dr. Segre will speak on "Poet Rutherford Nuclear Physics." The talk is general in nature.

The All-University Lectures were established under the terms of a recent private endowment to the University to provide greater interchange between the University's several campuses.

Dr. Segre won the Nobel prize (with Dr. Owen Chamberlain) in 1959 for demonstrating the existence of the anti-proton.

The second in the All-University Lecture series will be given on Thursday, April 5, when Maynard Amerine, Professor of Enology, University of California, Davis, speaks on "The Well-Tempered Wine Bibber."
